

INDIANA ACADEMY FOR SCIENCE, MATHEMATICS, AND HUMANITIES  
FEE STRUCTURE – 2010-2011 Academic Year

Enrollment Fee

All newly enrolled students must pay a \$100 non-refundable enrollment fee upon admission to the Indiana academy to hold their place in the class. The enrollment fee will be applied toward the first semester housing fee.

Textbook, Supply, and Laboratory Fees - Payable to the Indiana Academy

All students (except those qualifying for free or reduced lunch\*) will pay a \$100/semester textbook rental fee, a \$25/semester supply fee, and a \$5/semester laboratory fee if taking a lab science course.

Housing Fee – Payable to Ball State University

All students (except those qualifying for free or reduced lunch\*) will pay a \$900/semester housing fee (\$1800 for the year). Students qualifying for reduced lunch status will be exempted from \$1000 of this fee. Students qualifying for free lunch status will be exempted from \$1500 of this fee. *Families will be billed directly by Ball State and should return their payments in the envelope provided with their statement.*

Installment Plans

Installment plans are available for both the Academy textbook, supply, and laboratory fees and for the housing fee.

Financial Assistance

For those families who do not qualify for the free and reduced lunch program under the federal guidelines, donated funds are available. An application for financial assistance must be completed.

Optional Fees

All students will receive a wireless laptop computer for their use while enrolled at the Academy. Computer insurance is available for \$60 per year, payable at move-in. Because the Academy retains ownership of the computer, individual homeowner's insurance may not cover it. Please check with your insurance agent before declining Academy insurance. Students may purchase a school yearbook (\$46) or rent a graphing calculator (\$40 per year) if they do not possess one. However, all students must have a graphing calculator for use while enrolled.
