

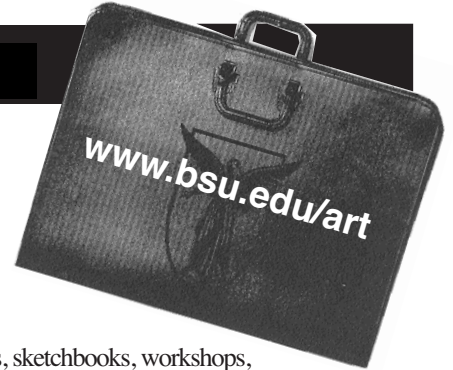


Open House and Portfolio Review

If you are a high school junior or senior, a parent, art teacher, or guidance counselor, you are invited! And it's free!

Did you say this was a portfolio review too?



To be an art major at Ball State University requires students to submit an art application along with a portfolio of current artwork. On this day students can bring actual artwork to be reviewed by faculty as part of the criteria for admissions.

- Presentation of your work is important. Take pride in your artwork and how you present it. A portfolio case can be purchased at any art store to protect your work. Since many portfolios are similar in appearance, please clearly label the outside of your portfolio with your name.
- Decide what you want to include in your portfolio. Work can come from classroom assignments, sketchbooks, workshops, pre-college programs, or work done "on your own" outside the classroom. No more than 15 pieces should be brought to this event. Remember at least three drawings from direct observation must be included as part of your portfolio.
- Bring your own laptop computer to showcase any digital artwork at this event such as digital video, computer animation, interactive art, and net-based projects. Be sure the work is in a finished format and limit any video clips to 2-3 minutes.
- To complete the admission process: applicants must complete and submit both the application for undergraduate admission to Ball State University (<http://cms.bsu.edu/AdmissionsLanding/UndergraduateAdmissions.aspx>) AND the art program application. If applying online, indicate art as the intended major and the application request form will appear.
- If you have applied to Ball State University you are encouraged to submit the art application at this event.
- To be considered for scholarships, all materials must be received by March 1 deadline: submission of both the art program application and scholarship application, essay, resume, recommendation form, inventory sheet, and portfolio submitted on a CD as a PowerPoint presentation. **Students must be admitted to Ball State University to be considered for scholarships.**
