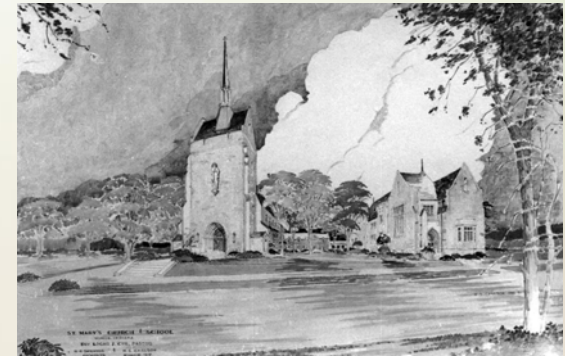


Hearing Voices from the Past: The Middletown Digital Oral History Collection





Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA) Digitization Grant, 2006-07

- Federal funds from the Institute of Museum and Library Services given to each state and administered by the State Library
- Second consecutive LSTA digitization grant awarded to Ball State University Libraries
- Grant funds of \$25,125 for project
- Project collaboration with Center for Middletown Studies
