Deadlines

CAP has a competitive, rolling admission review process. Decision notification will be sent upon review. Students are strongly encouraged to apply as early as possible. First-priority consideration will be given to applications with all required materials received by **December 1, 2021**. Applications received after this date will be considered as space is available.

Students with outstanding academic records may be offered early admission and will be notified immediately following the review of their application materials.

Essay (REQUIRED)

Please submit a brief, typed essay (500 words maximum) addressing both of the following of the topics below. **Include your Full Name, City, Birth Date and Email Address at the top of your submittal.**

1. Describe a place in your community of which you are fond and would take a visitor to experience. In the same community, discuss another place that you find unacceptable and would like to change. Explain how you would preserve the character of the place you are fond of, and what you would change to help the place you find unacceptable. Optional: you are welcome to support your proposal with one or two original drawings of these spaces.
2. Describe a time when you experienced a setback and explain how you were able to overcome that setback.

Attach the essay to this form; your application will not be considered without it. Please sign your name to certify the authenticity of your essay.
