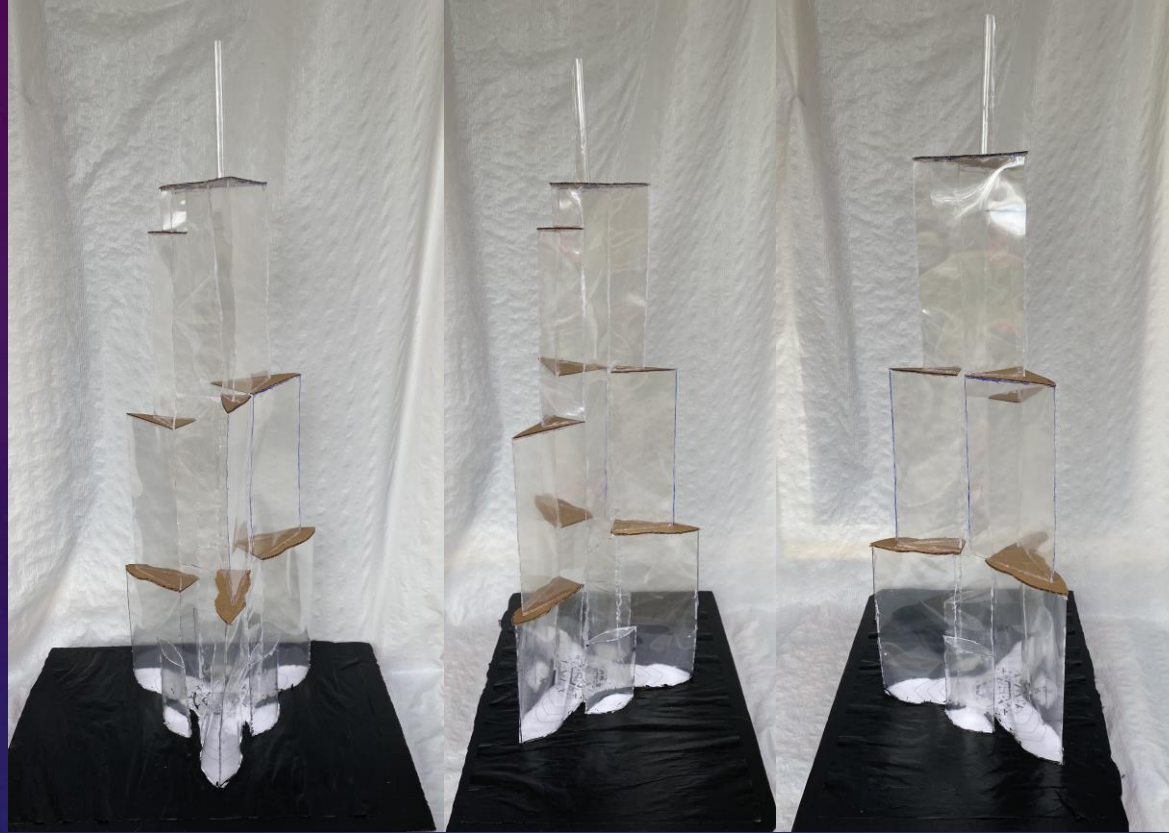

# MEET THE ARTIST



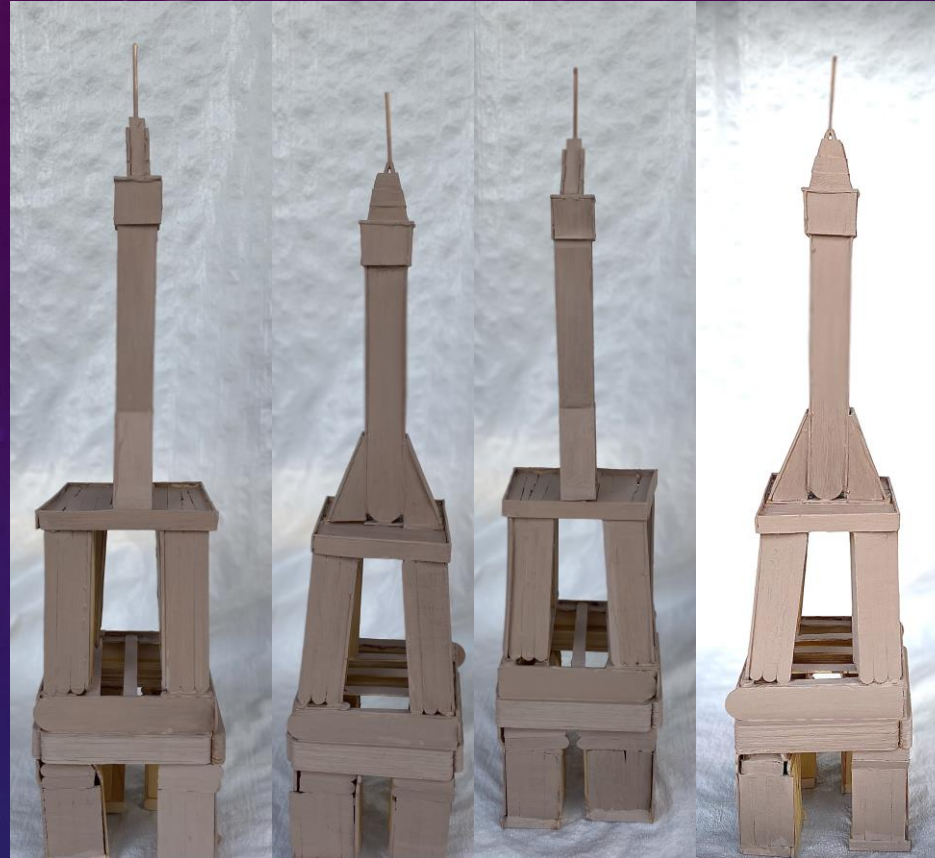

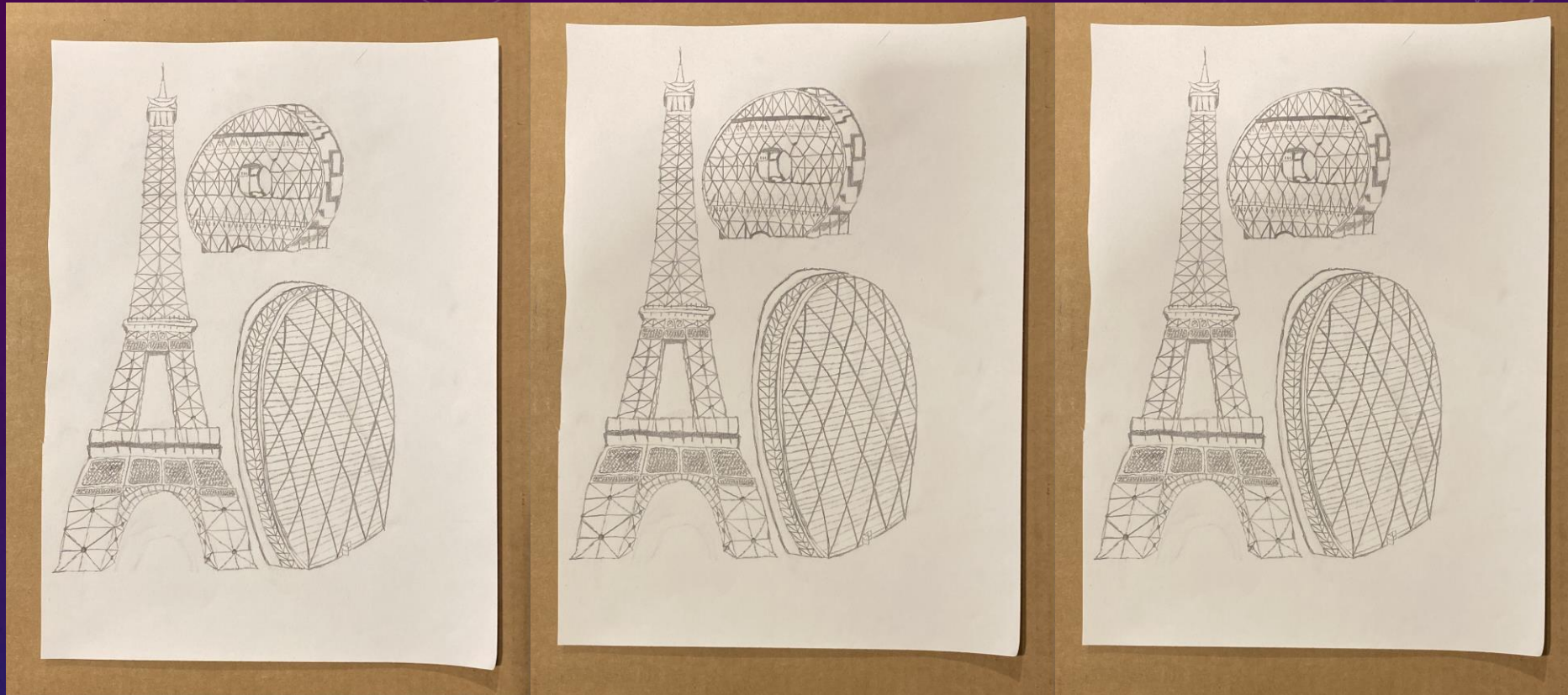

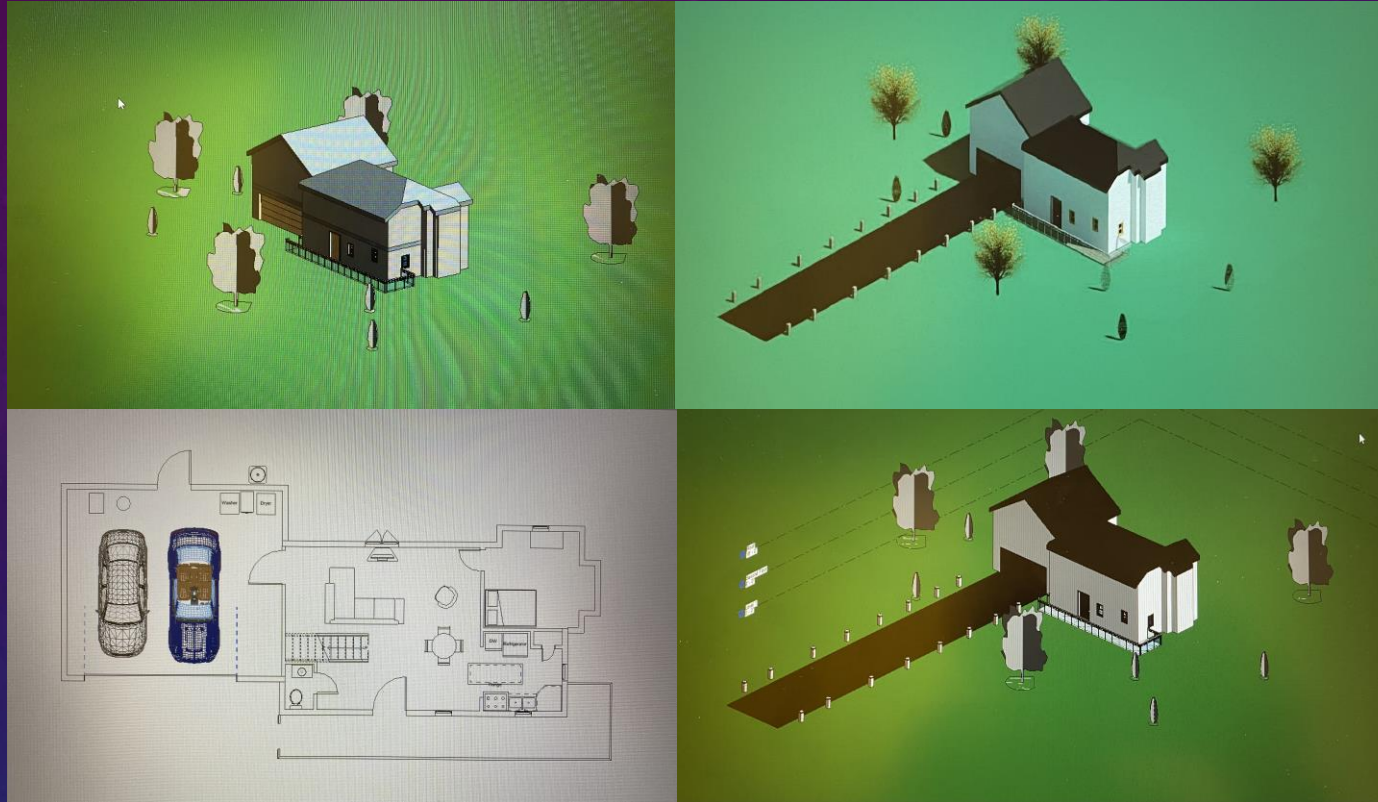

These are photos that were taken in my backyard and I was instructed to edit the pictures for my AP 3-D Art Class to create a whole new look upon them.



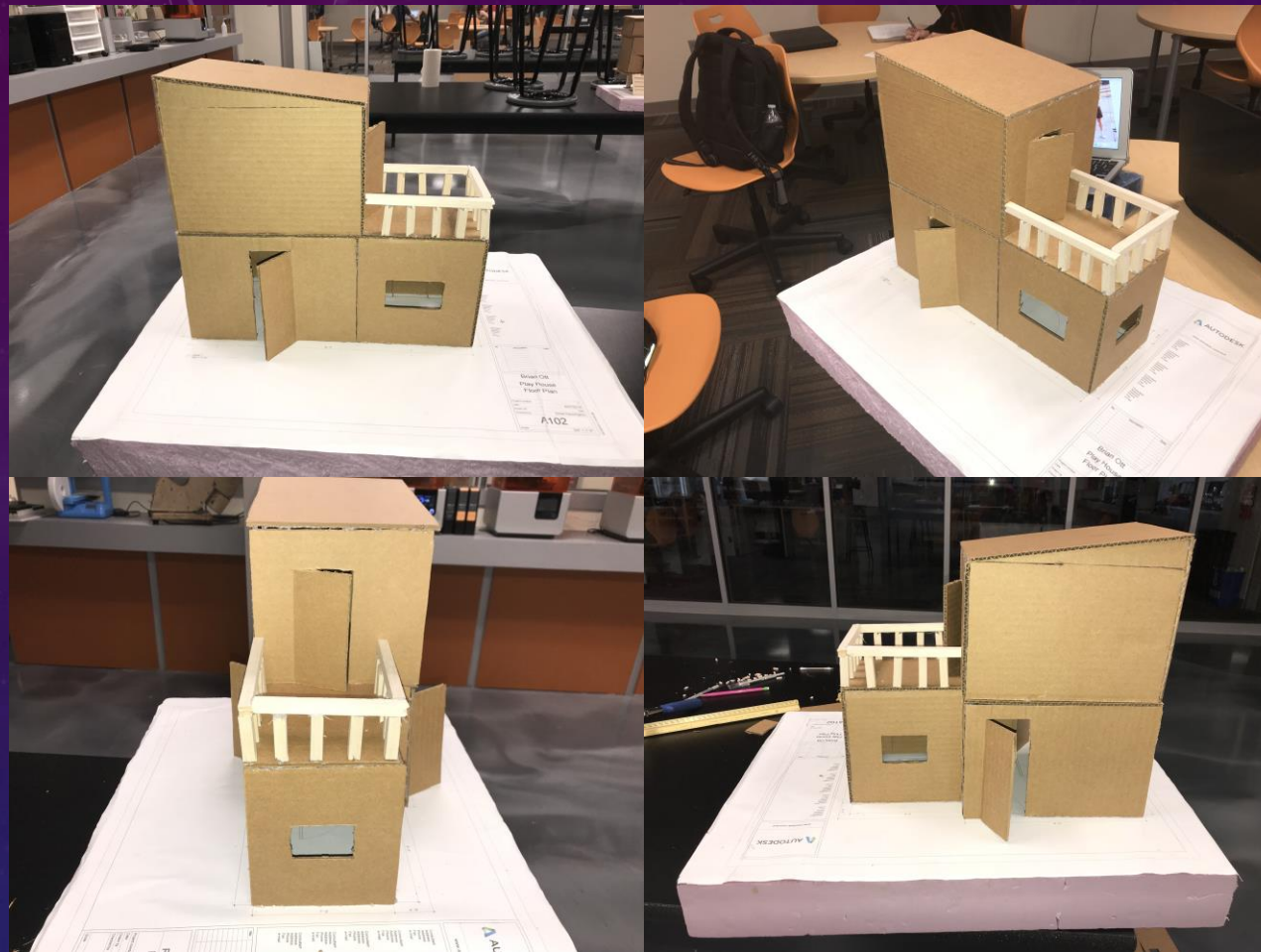
These are the renderings and floor plan for my Affordable House project in my CEA class(Civil Engineering and Architecture). I used Revit Office 2019.
