

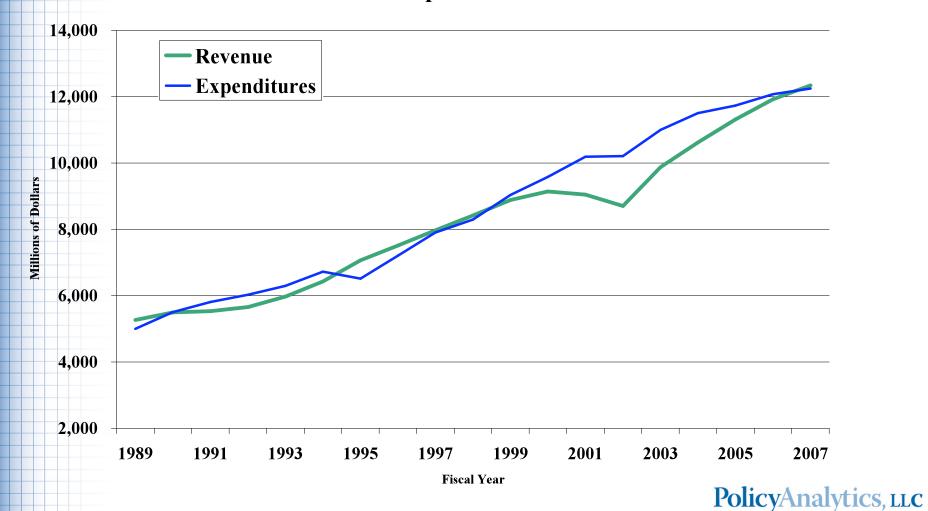

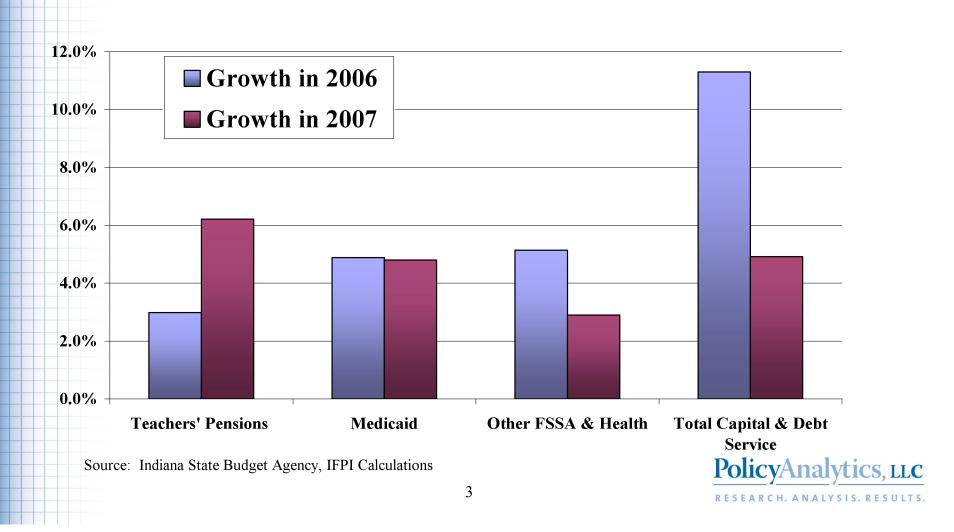
Indiana General & Property Tax Replacement Fund Budget: Revenue and Expenditures - 1989 to 2007

Where the Budget did NOT Appropriate Increases Annual Percent Changes over Prior Year

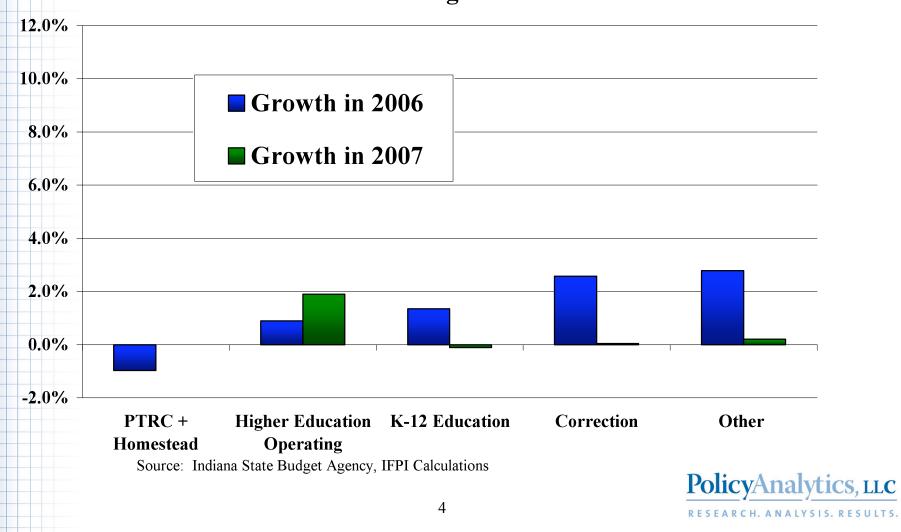
