

COFFEE TABLE PURPOSEFUL DESIGN Designed By: Cassandra Martin



This coffee table was designed for Purposeful Designs. Made up completely of walnut wood, and the legs being painted black. The inspiration for this piece was from designer and architect, Alvar Aalto, I created curvilinear accents within the pieces to give a feeling of the flexibility and freedom that he stood for. Simplicity is seen throughout with no hardware on the outside of the coffee table. The nitch is provided to slide the door and reveal the storage within the coffee table. The slideable door adds levels and gives the piece of furniture purpose and flexibilty to change the aesthetic of the coffee table.
