Participation in orientation prior to beginning a placement at the Counseling Center is required. Please plan your schedule accordingly.

Application Process

There are positions available for the 2026-2027 academic year. If you are interested in applying for a psychology master's intern position, submit the following materials in one email to CCTraining@bsu.edu. All application materials must be submitted to receive full consideration.

1. Cover letter that addresses the following areas:
 - a. Share a bit about yourself (e.g., background, interests, self-care)
 - b. Why are you interested in training at the Ball State University Counseling Center?
 - c. What are you hoping to take away from this training experience?
 - d. What do you bring (e.g., experience, skills, characteristics) that might help you adapt and grow during a training year in the Counseling Center?
2. Curriculum vitae

Applications are accepted beginning **January 12, 2026**. Interviews with members of the Counseling Center Training Committee begin **January 19, 2026** and continue until all positions are filled.
