Dissertation: *The (Un)Common Reader: Investigating Common Reader Pedagogy in First-Year Writing Courses*

Using descriptive, qualitative case studies, I explored three first-year writing instructors' experiences with teaching a common reader. While each case provides a unique approach, I found commonalities across the instructors' experiences, such as mixed messages from the university, assumptions about the program, and conflicting feelings in students' responses.
