BIOGRAPHIES



Dr. **Jeremy Harmon** is Associate Director of Bands and Director of the Ball State University "Pride of Mid-America" Marching Band. His duties include directing the "POMA" Marching Band, pep bands, conductor of the Wind Symphony, as well as other courses. He previously served as the Director of Athletic Bands at Bowling Green State University, Director of Bands at Garfield High School in Woodbridge, Virginia, and Director of Bands at Vinton County Local Schools in McArthur, Ohio.

A native of Dover, Ohio, Dr. Harmon has degrees from Ohio University and University of Kentucky. He is currently active as an arranger and drill writer for the Ball State University Marching Band, University of Kentucky Wildcat Marching Band, and also arranges for the University of Maryland "Mighty Sound of Maryland" Marching Band, the Ohio University Marching 110, and numerous high schools around the country.

His primary teachers have included Dr. Cody Birdwell (Conducting), Dr. Richard Suk, Dr. Andrew Trachsel (Conducting), and Dr. Matthew James (Saxophone). Dr. Harmon is a member of various professional and honorary societies including Kappa Kappa Psi, Tau Beta Sigma, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, Pi Kappa Lambda, as well as affiliations with the College Band Directors National Association, the Ohio Music Educators Association (Professional Development Conference Clinician), and the National Association for Music Education.



Dr. **Thomas E. Caneva** is Director of Bands, Professor of Music and Coordinator of Ensembles and Conducting at Ball State University. Since his arrival in 2006, the BSU Wind Ensemble has been invited to perform at the 2011, 2017 and 2023 CBDNA National Conferences, the 2010 and 2014 CBDNA North Central Division Conferences, the 2012 and 2022 Conventions of the American Bandmasters Association and the IMEA Professional Development Conferences in 2009, 2011 and 2017.

In 2007, Dr. Caneva founded the Ball State University Wind Band Conducting Workshop, which has attracted aspiring conductors from throughout the United States. An advocate of new repertoire for wind band, Dr. Caneva has been a part of more than forty commissioning projects and premieres with the BSU Band program.

In 2001, Dr. Caneva was elected to membership in the prestigious American Bandmasters Association, where he currently serves as the Chair of the Sousa-ABA-Ostwald Composition Contest Committee. He is the Indiana State Chair of CBDNA and recently served as President of the MAC Band Directors Association. In 2014, he was elected to membership in Phi Beta Mu. Since 2011, he has served as the Concert Band Division Coordinator for the Music for All Summer Symposium and is a Conn-Selmer Educational Clinician.

Dr. Caneva holds degrees from the University of Illinois, University of Texas and the University of Colorado.
