Award decisions will be released in June 2024, applicants will be notified via email, and funds will be deposited into the awardee's Bursar/Student Account for use in the 2024-25 school year. (Please note some awards may be divided between Fall and Spring semesters, and if an awardee has a balance due in their Bursar/Student Account the scholarship funds will be applied to any unpaid balance first before dispersing to the student's personal bank account.)
