All applicants who are approved by the Credentials Board will be required to give a two (2) minute presentation before the Senate explaining their desire to be instated as a Senator. A two (2) minute Question and Answer session will occur at the conclusion of the applicant's presentation followed by a private Senate Discussion and vote. A two thirds (2/3) majority vote by the Senate is needed for an applicant to become a Senator.

At-Large Caucus This caucus serves as a "catch all" and is comprised of any Ball State student who wishes to serve as a Senator, but not be restricted to one of the four specific caucus types.

Collegiate Caucus This caucus is comprised of one student from each college. Every student in this caucus must be declared in a college. Each college may have no more than one (1) student representative. New applicants may apply for a seat to represent a college only if there is no current Senator representing said college. Students in Exploratory Studies are not permitted to serve in this caucus.

- Shall visit two (2) different student organizations per semester.
