

Data from Select Questions on Ball State University Principal Alumni Survey

This survey was administered to 267 principals in April of 2021. There was a total of 82 respondents (27.6% response rate). Of the 82 respondents, 77 identified that they were prepared by Ball State University. The following table displays data from survey questions designed to provide evidence that candidates in the M.A.E. in Educational Administration and Supervision (which leads to an Indiana Educator License for Building Level Administration) feel well-prepared in the National Educational Leadership Preparation (NELP) Standards.
